

**GUIDANCE FOR VISITING RESIDENTS AT FELLOWSHIP COMMUNITY
Manor, Terrace and Villa Buildings**

- 1. Visitation is allowed at all times for all residents**
- 2. Visitation rules and core infection control principles:**
 - Enter through the Manor or Terrace front entrance for COVID screening
 - Utilize the electronic kiosk to complete COVID screening process, visitor check in and obtain visitor ID badge
 - Residents & visitors must wear a surgical mask that will be available at the entrance. The mask must be properly fitted over the nose and mouth at all times while visiting, traveling through the buildings or in common areas. This also applies to children over 2 years of age. There are no exceptions. Mask wearing will be strictly enforced.
 - Refrain from eating or drinking during your visit
 - Maintain a 6-foot social distance from residents and staff as much as possible
 - Use hand sanitizer before and after visitation
 - Visitor ID badge must be on and visible during the visit
 - Proceed to the nursing station for the area your loved one resides for any resident specific instructions if you have been informed about an outbreak or exposure situation
 - Sign out at the end of the visit
 - Non – compliance will result in termination of visitation privileges
 - CDC recommends being up to date with vaccination. UP TO DATE means that you have received all recommended COVID-19 vaccines INCLUDING any booster dose(s) when eligible
 - Stay home if you are ill or if you have had an exposure to a COVID positive person for 10 days
 - If you have tested positive for COVID you cannot visit until at least 10 days have passed and your symptoms have improved
 - Notify the nursing staff if you have been exposed or contracted the virus within 48 hours of visiting
 - Current COVID case numbers for facility are available on our website, internal TV message boards, and through one-call updates
